Secretary This past year (year ending January 31st, 2023) we received many requests from our on-line donation program. We disbursed \$9,500 to charities that met our criteria. The donation matching program we offered in 2022 to our shareholders enabled us to match a total of **\$28,800 – up by almost \$10,000 from last Emilio Dente** year (\$18,942). Through this initiative, we matched 33 charities and in 2021 we matched 24. Please see Director page 4 for a list of the charities we supported through these two programs. The Charity Board of Directors can't stress enough to take advantage of this program - the charities you support in your community will be matched by UMC Charity. Director At this point in our existence, our major source of funding comes directly from you - our shareholders and your stores. If advantage is taken of the matching program, we all stand to gain, both in the pride of giving **Ron Gracan** and the increased status we can gain in our communities. We now rely even more so on the \$50 monthly store donations in order to ensure the survival of the donation matching funds program for our shareholders. Director We maintained the amount of support of \$16,560 - up slightly from 2021 (\$10,560). If you have not already done so, please consider signing up! You will receive a registered charity receipt from UMC Charity for this donation which can be used for tax purposes. As well, for those stores that participate in the \$50 per month program, gives you the ability to donation match up to \$1500. Our new donation matching amount for those who do not participate in the \$50 per month initiative, is now \$500. That is an extra \$1000 we will match to your charity in your community if you join that initiative. The majority of our funds normally come from the Annual uniPHARM Spring Convention's silent and live auction event. The net proceeds raised are donated to UMC charity. Thankfully, the event was held in 2022 and we were able to receive from uniPHARM, \$35,050! The last one that was held in 2019 raised \$28,016.
